DSHS DBHR-NSMHA-PIHP-15-16 Amendment 1 for the purpose of increasing the Medicaid rates for adults and the newly eligible. The term of the agreement remains the same July 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016.

DSHS DBHR-NSMHA-SMHC-15-16 Amendment 1 for the purpose of increasing funding by \$1,012,626.00 for a new maximum consideration of \$12,366,000.00 with the term of the agreement remaining the same July 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016.

NSMHA will be developing administrative contracts with new Substance Use Disorder providers to facilitate the infrastructure to prepare for contracting with NSMHA.

- Therapeutic Health Services
- Evergreen Recovery Services

The contracts below are for two (2) experienced individuals to participate on the Family Youth System Partner Round Tables (FYSPRTs) to represent the North Sound Mental Health Administration as the Family Partner FYSPRT Tri-Lead. The FYSPRT is a key component for ensuring behavioral health and other public child, youth, and family serving systems in Washington State are coordinated and informed by input from multiple stakeholders.

Julie de Losada distributed a handout and addressed the Board regarding the two contracts below and provided background for the Board, noting that all of this stems from the TR Lawsuit against the state. Questions, answer and discussion took place throughout Julie's presentation.

NSMHA-LAKEY-PSC-16 for the purpose of reimbursing a parent partner for their work on the FYSPRT in the North Sound. The maximum consideration on this agreement is \$6,000 with the term of the agreement October 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016.

NSMHA-WEAVER-PSC-16 for the purpose of reimbursing a youth partner for their work on the FYSPRT in the North Sound. The maximum consideration on this agreement is \$5,400 with the term of the agreement October 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016.
