NORTH SOUND BH-ASO MAT-PDOA PROJECT PROVIDES MAT TO EASTERN SKAGIT COUNTY

The MAT PDOA (Mediation Assisted Treatment – Prescription Drug and Opioid Addiction) project has successfully brought medication assisted treatment (MAT) to Eastern Skagit county. Lifeline Connections is now providing MAT treatment, including care navigation and recovery services in Concrete, WA. HCA EMERGENCY RESPONSE FOR SUICIDE PREVENTION GRANT

The Health Care Authority (HCA) received funds to work with the University of Washington Harborview Medical Center (UWHMC) Behavioral Health Institute (BHI) to develop a support plan for adults who have a suicide crisis. The plan includes Peer Navigators and a tablet-based JASP Health app for individuals ages 25 and older including victims of domestic violence, and suicide prevention training for behavioral health providers.
