The window is now open to begin testing all supplemental transactions included in version 4.0 of the Health Care Authority (HCA) *Behavioral Health Data System Data Guide* found here. Testing commenced on July 1, 2020 and North Sound BH-ASO Information Services staff are ready to provide support any way we can.

We want to remind providers that all supplemental data collected since January 1, 2020 will need to be submitted to North Sound BH-ASO. We want to get everyone testing as soon as possible so there is no delay in getting this information by the official October 1, 2020 start date.
