12. Introduction Items

1) Pioneer Human Services

PHS is requesting startup funding for the Snohomish County Denny Facility in the amount of \$143,790.32 for IT equipment and a vehicle for program use. 32 beds are being transferred from Pioneer Center North to the Everett facility, 16 withdrawal management and 16 co-occurring. PHS is also applying for a grant to cover smaller capital costs.

This would be a cost reimbursement contract.

- o Vehicle \$31,995.32
- o IT Equipment \$111,795

2) Behavioral Health Enhancement Funds (BHEF)

This funding is a legislative proviso to help providers recruit and retain staff. After surveying providers, we requested proposals on the usage of the funds. We receive \$992,088.00 per year in BHEF. The asks were higher than our allocation, so we've allocated the funds based on the provision of ASO services they are currently providing.
